About Q-linea

Over the past six years, Q-linea has developed innovative systems for in vitro diagnostics of infectious diseases. Q-linea's leading product, ASTar, is much faster than today's methods at determining which antibiotics are effective against an infection, a procedure known as an AST. ASTar is expected to shorten the time it takes to identify the proper treatment of patients with sepsis by more than 24 hours. The method has substantial potential to save lives, reduce hospital costs, avoid unnecessary antibiotic treatment resulting in bacterial resistance development.

Q-linea strives to establish and then strengthen the Company's position as a key player in diagnosing infectious diseases through the development of innovative diagnostics platforms with the potential to be both first-in-class and best-in-class.
